Road Sealcoating Project Almost Complete For those who may have been away for the summer, you will be pleasantly surprised when you return to Watercrest with the beautiful appearance of our newly sealed roads. The majority of the project was completed in early July after only one short delay due to vendor equipment breakdown. It should be noted that a few touch-ups will be scheduled to repair some white intersection striping as well to repair some damage to sealcoating on Bluff caused by a pool contractor A special thanks to Board member Sam Ferguson who coordinated the project and to the many volunteers who helped this project come to fruition without a hitch. Thank you to all the residents as well for your cooperation in dealing with the partial road closures.



The North Fence Erosion Control Project is wrapping up. The erosion control project landscaping is wrapping up. The irrigation system in the area has recently been repaired with sprinkler heads added with mulch and sod currently being installed. The irrigation system will run for about a month for the new sod. Should you see dry spots, any additional watering by the homeowners would be helpful. The board appreciates the Wingood homeowners' patience as we bring this project to closure.

**Roof Cleaning** The majority of homeowners have cleaned their roofs of dirt, mildew and other growth earlier this year.
