Hurricane Milton The Board continues to assess damage to the community. The primary damage was to the north and east PVC fences which had several panels blown out from the hurricane force winds. Thanks to Board members and homeowners who gathered fence slats that were reuseable and who made minor repairs. Some fence repairs will require replacing damaged posts. Vendors have been contacted for repairs to the fences and other areas (e.g. traffic signs, gates, amenity center roof, etc.) but please be patient as all vendors are obviously very busy and some parts may be in short supply. We also experienced downed trees and uprooted bushes. Artistree, our landscape vendor, began picking up debris just 4 days after the storm and completed their routine mowing a few days later. Thanks to Alan Williams and the Artistree crews for getting our grounds back in shape so quickly.

If you have downed trees or leaning trees that may survive by staking, please let Sean@sunstatemanagment.com know and he will add your name and address to the list. Downed trees and stumps will be removed by the HOA. Trees that can be staked will also be covered by the HOA. Replacement of damaged trees and bushes caused by the hurricane will be the responsibility of the homeowner.

Finally, <u>please remove or retract your hurricane shutters</u> as required by our declaration of restrictions and our community wide standards (CWS). Shutters are to be removed or retracted from your home no later than 7 days after the date when the National Weather Service (NWS) hurricane watch or warning is withdrawn or when Venice is no longer within the NWS five day "cone of uncertainty."

Additional Landscaping Updates Please be advised that the <u>replacement sod</u> project that was originally scheduled for late spring/early summer is still on hold as the Board assesses the community damage from Hurricane Milton and its associated cost. (This hold does not include the sod that is part of the North Fence repair project that has been worked on for the last couple of months). This sod will be installed in the near future. It should also be noted that any changes to irrigation (EXCEPT FOR NORMAL REPAIRS) will be billed to the homeowner and not paid for by the HOA.

North Fence Project This project is nearing completion as we are awaiting arrival and installation of the last pallets of sod. Wingood residents, thank you again for your patience.
